

SECTORS OF INTERVENTIONS

1. EMERGENCY RESPONSE

YEU conducts emergency response in an inclusive manner, paying attention to the needs and priorities of at-risk groups, promoting gender equality, and actively involving communities in humanitarian interventions.



2. DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

YEU applies locally-led and inclusive approach in its efforts to strengthen community resilience and preparedness for disasters and the impacts of climate change.

YEU assists a number of initiatives to strengthen local leadership by supporting community groups, undertaking participatory risk mapping, identifying vulnerabilities and capacities, and prioritizing resilience actions.

YEU promotes the integration of preparedness measures into local development planning and budgeting to be more inclusive, transparent, and accountable.




3. CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION

YEU builds capacity and strengthens community resilience in facing the threat of climate change in coastal areas, the agricultural sector and the environment protection.

YEU facilitates the resilience of coastal area communities (including mangrove conservation), strengthening the capacity of farmers in climate adaptive agriculture, water source conservation, tree planting, irrigation and making alternative animal feed.

YEU works together with communities in managing household and plastic waste to reduce emissions by waste segregation, strengthening community waste banks, managing organic and inorganic waste.




